

# Natural protection zones with flight restrictions in the alps

Pilots are used to see it on VFR charts, but based on legal regulations in the various regions, many zones with flight restrictions in the alps unfortunately are not visible in the charts. Getting into these zones with an aircraft can end up with a statutory complaint and extreme high costs. Due to this background we should stay clear from airspace with 'national parks' and 'bird sanctuaries'. As additional frame condition it's important to know, that sometimes the ceiling of such zones is specified in relation to the 'ground level', in other cases with 'mean sea level' (MSL) as reference.

With the latest updates, SkyDemon also provides this kind of information. By amending of the display settings, this kind of information is provided direct on the chart. During the process with flight planning the information with 'bird sanctuaries' is also shown in the 'altitude profile'. To get the zones displayed direct, inside the display settings the option 'Other local airspace' must be activated. The most simple, save and reliable approach to stay outside of such air space is to follow the GAFOR flight routes for the alps, which are also displayed in SkyDemon.



#### Picture 1 - Example with Screen of SkyDemon running on PC





#### The big 'national park Hohe Tauern' in Austria – ceiling with Flight Level 165






